

2012-2013 Class Offerings

For children to derive the most benefit out of a language immersion program, it is important that they have daily contact with the target language. Most of our programs run five days per week so that your child can become bilingual.



The academic year runs for nine months, September through May. Please see the school calendar for holidays and days off. These are our program hours:

Morning class:	8:45 a.m.	–	11:45 a.m.
Afternoon class:	12:45 p.m.	–	3:45 p.m.
Full-day classes:	8:45 a.m.	–	3:45 p.m.

Toddlers: At least 24 months by Sept. 1st. We recommend the 5-day program for all children. However, new students **under 30 months** may choose to attend 2 or 3 days per week during the first semester and 5 days starting in January. Only morning classes are offered for two year olds. 12 students per class.

Three-year olds to 1st grade: At least 36 months by Sept. 1st 2012. Morning, afternoon, and full-day schedules available. **All students attend 5 days per week.** 16 students per class.

Additional Fees

- Annual materials fee (includes student workbooks and textbooks):
 - \$140 for half-day students
 - \$190 for full-day students
 - \$390 for Kindergarten students, \$690 for first graders
- Student uniforms: \$25 per smock
- \$250 one-time enrollment fee (new students only)

Tuition Payments

Preschool: Although it is expected that students will attend for a full academic year, tuition commitments are on a semester basis (September – December / January – May.) A full semester tuition commitment is required.

Kindergarten & First Grade: These classes require a **full academic year** tuition commitment.

To secure a spot, a non-refundable deposit is required upon enrollment:

- 10% of annual tuition, which will be applied to the second semester payment
- Corresponding annual supply fee
- \$250 one-time enrollment fee (new students only)

Payment terms:

- Bi-annually -50% of tuition due by August 15th
-Remaining 40% of tuition due by Dec. 15th
- Monthly:* -10% deposit will be applied to the month of May 2013
-8 equal monthly payments are due on the 15th of each month (August – March)

* All families wishing to make monthly payments are required to sign a tuition contract and make payments via direct deposit. A \$25 administrative fee is added to each of the direct deposit payments.
